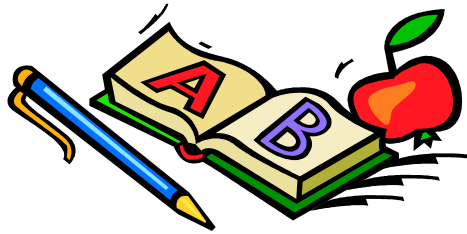


Mrs. Herrmann's Kindergarten Parent Night

2. Kindergarten Reminders:

-Make sure all your child's supplies are turned in.

-Homework Folders: Students needs to take their folder home and bring it back daily!

-Homework Policy:

-Students are responsible to take their homework out of their folder and put it into the turn in bin independently.

-Tuesday (clear) Folders: These folders go home once a month on Tuesday and need to be returned the following day; Wednesday back to me.

-Gym: A and C Days

-Music B and E Days

-Library D Days- One week they go to the computer lab and the other is book check out.

- We do have a bathroom and drink break every day.
